NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY
Notice to Beneficiaries

Community Access Unlimited, Inc. is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from, or denied the benefits of, our services on the basis of race, creed, color, or national origin as protected by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended. Any person who believes that they have, individually, or as a member of any specific class of persons, been subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin, may file a complaint in writing to Community Access Unlimited, Inc. To file a complaint, or for more information under Community Access Unlimited, Inc. obligations under Title VI write to Transportation Services at 80 West Grand Street, NJ or visit our website at www.caunj.org. Transportation services provided by this agency are in whole or part funded through federal funds received through NJ Transit and as an individual you also have the right to file your complaint under Title VI by writing to Title VI Program Coordinator, East Building 5th Floor- TCR, US Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, 1200 New Jersey Ave, SE, Washington, DC 20590. A complaint must be filed within 180 days of the alleged discrimination.
