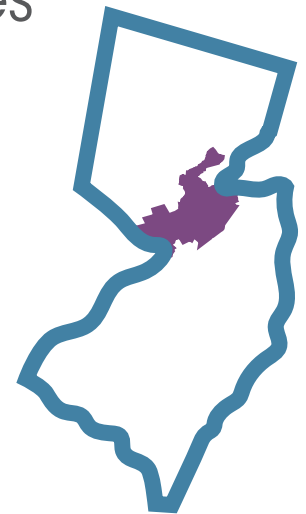

Bonnie Watson Coleman*, D

- Coleman is the first African American woman to represent New Jersey in Congress. Watson Coleman is a member of the Appropriations Committee and the Homeland Security Committee, where she serves as Chair of the Subcommittee on Transportation and Maritime Security.
- Coleman is fighting for the Customer Non-Discrimination Act, which would amend the Civil Rights Act of 1964 to prohibit discrimination based on sex, sexual orientation, and gender identity in “public accommodations,” such as schools, recreational facilities and retail stores.
- Coleman is working to pass laws that make it easier for Americans to register to vote and to gain access to the ballot box.
